Selection Requirements:

- Demonstrates commitment to the greater church by participating in ministries outside of youth (Acolyte, Choir Member, Church Under the Bridge, Greeter, Children's Chapel Helper, or Breakfast Team).
- Desires to lead and is willing to grow as a leader.
- Committed to spiritual growth of self and others.
- Able to attend leadership events.

Responsibilities:

- Planning of nightly and weekend activities for youth including worship, service, fellowship, and study opportunities.
- Meets regularly to evaluate and expand on youth ministries at Christ Church Cathedral.
- Participates regularly in planning, visioning, and spiritual direction sessions
- Prays daily for youth ministries at Christ Church Cathedral
- Leads discussions in Sunday School and youth activities.
- Represents voice of Rite-13ers, J2Aers, and YACers on the youth council.
- Communicates regularly with Youth Ministries Coordinator, Sunday School teachers, and students.

Requirements:

Youth council members should have Sunday morning and afternoon schedules free from school and extracurricular activities in the 2010-2011 school year. Bios must be submitted by May 9.
