

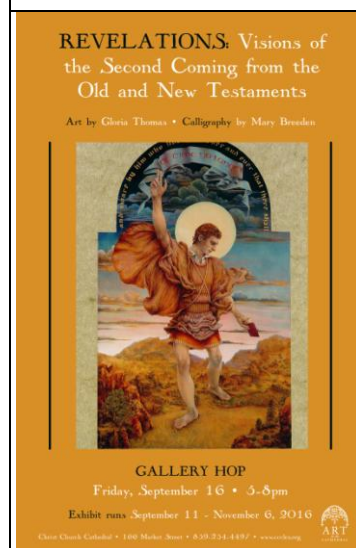
Art at the Cathedral – Exhibits 2016-17



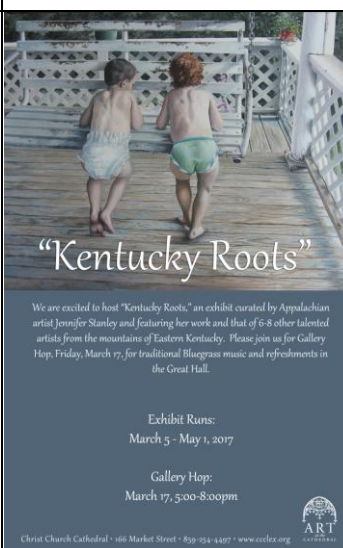
July 1-Sept 4, 2016 - **“America the Beautiful”** - an exhibit curated by Jesse Mark featuring the work of 32 artists from New York to Hawaii. The patriotic song served as the guide for the artistic content of the exhibit.



Jan 8-Feb 26, 2017 - **“Photographs by Michelle Dunlap”** – an exhibit of 50-60 photos by our beloved Cathedral photographer.



Sept. 11 – Nov. 6, 2016 - **“Revelations: Visions of the Second Coming from the Old and New Testaments”** - an exhibit featuring the artwork of Gloria Thomas and calligraphy by Mary Breeden based on the Book of Revelations.



Mar. 5-May 1, 2017 – **“Kentucky Roots”** – An exhibit curated by Appalachian artist Jennifer Stanley featuring artists from the mountains & knobs of Eastern Kentucky.



Nov. 13-Jan. 3, 2017 - **“Quiltography 2016” & “Quilting Emotions”** – Two exhibits in one. The first features over 100 small quilts produced by the Quilt Artists of Kentucky (“QAK”) interpreting 8 artistic photographs



May 7-June 26, 2017 – **“Sayre Student Art”** – An art exhibit featuring art produced by high school students from Sayre School.
