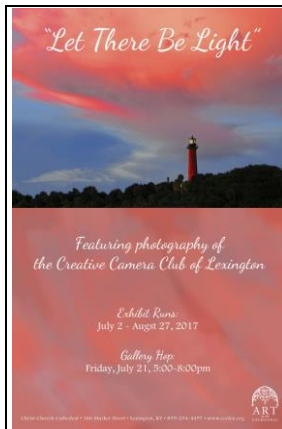


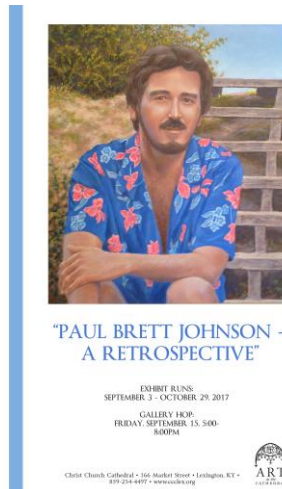
# Art at the Cathedral – Exhibits 2017-18



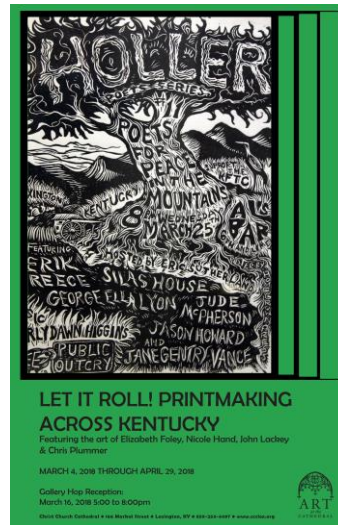

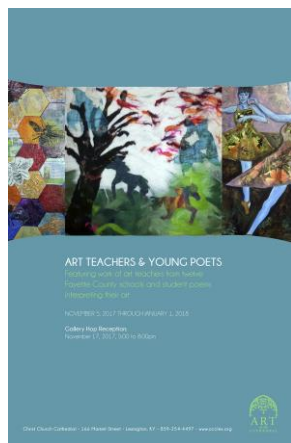

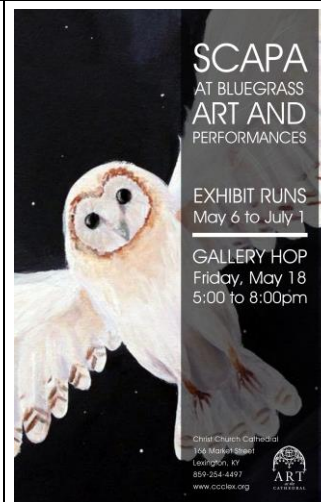
